School Census Day- Census Day will take place next Thursday, 18 May, and is an important day for the school. On this day, data is collected from the school which is used to calculate some of our funding for the next financial year. As well as recording the number of children on roll it also records our uptake of Free School Meals (FSM) and Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) on that particular day. This then informs our funding to run the kitchen for the next year. We do not make any money from the kitchen and school does need to use other funds in order to run it however we do get some grant funding that supports this.

It is for this reason that we are asking for your support to ensure that we maximise meal numbers on that day. As far as possible, we would like every child who is entitled to a Free School Meal or a Universal Infant Free School Meal (all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children) to have a school lunch. If they normally have a packed lunch and would like to try a dinner on this day, they can do this and still bring in their packed lunch in case they do not like it.

Allotment: we would love to have some volunteers to support the running and maintenance of our school allotment. We are grateful to a parent for already volunteering and we are asking if there are other people who would have the capacity to help as part of a group. School Dinner Money: You can use the School Gateway app to easily keep track of your child's dinner money. The current balance is always displayed in the main screen under 'Lunch Money'. To add money to their account click on 'Lunch Money' then 'Top up Balance' then 'School Dinner Money'. Type in the amount you want to top up and then click add to basket and make payment by card or bank transfer. Your child's account should always be in credit before they order a lunch.
