Strike days: The first of National Education Union Industrial action days has passed with 02, 15 and 16 March still to come unless a resolution is reached. We advise you to put a plan in place for these days, should your child's class be affected. Please note that it isn't automatically the same teachers each time some may choose to strike for one or more of those days. This does mean that some classes may be more impacted than others. We respect the right of staff to take industrial action and under the Government guidance we are required to take all reasonable steps to keep the school open. If your child's teacher makes the decision to strike, the class will be closed. We may not know in advance so you will be notified as soon as possible but it may be on the morning. If there are not enough teachers and/or leaders on site, for the school to operate safely, then the entire school will close. Given the nature of the strikes, it may not be possible to inform you until the morning of any closure. As stated earlier, please prepare alternative childcare arrangements on the dates of industrial action in case it is needed. A letter went out yesterday via School Gateway informing you of 3 classes that we know will be closed on Thursday 2 March: 1AM, 2G and 3P. Thank you for your support and understanding.
